DETAIL:

Amador - El Dorado Unit: The AEU Lightning Complex had 8 fires for 10 acres. All fires are contained. No further reports.

Butte Unit: The BTU Lightning Complex is 27 fires for 4,500 acres. 18 active fires. 2 are unstaffed. 7 fires have been contained. Many of the fires are in remote areas. The Fires continue to threaten the communities of Concow, Magalia, and Paradise with 413 structures potentially threatened. The "Smokey" Fire is making hard runs. 250 Boy Scouts had to be evacuated. Incident Command Team #9 assigned.

Humboldt Unit: The HUU Lightning Complex is 52 fires for 950 acres. 9 active fires. 2 fires are unstaffed. 43 fires have been contained. The Paradise fire is of most significance and is 500 acres in size, 25% contained, and remotely located. Fuels are characterized by heavy brush with scattered patches of dense timber. 4 other Federal fires are also burning in Humboldt County.

Lassen - Modoc Unit: The LMU June Lightning Complex is 49 fires for 2,800 acres. 2 active fires. All fires are staffed. 47 fires have been contained. The Popcorn fire under unified command is 3,100 acres, 25% contained, and is threatening the communities of Little Valley and Pittville with potential of 6,000 acres. The Corral "1-6" Fire has burned 250 acres of heavy timber and is 5% contained. A new start in commercial timber has burned 250 acres.

Mendocino Unit: The MEU Lightning Complex is 106 fires for 19,200 acres. 74 active fires. 52 fires are unstaffed, 33 have been contained. Evacuations in the communities of Covelo, Navarro and portions of Ukiah are anticipated. Voluntary evacuations have occurred in the Foster Creek area. 525 residences are threatened and 5 have been destroyed. Fires continue to burn with varying rates of spread in moderate to very heavy fuels. Fuel types vary from heavy timber to brush and grass/oak woodland. Incident command Team #4 assigned.

Nevada-Yuba-Placer Unit: The NEU Lightning Complex was 3 fires for 80 acres. All fires contained during initial attack. No further reports

Santa Clara Unit: The SCU Lightning Complex was 2 fires for 994 acres. All fires are contained. No further reports.

San Mateo - Santa Cruz Unit: One fire for 300 acres is contained. No further reports.

Shasta - Trinity Unit: The SHU Lightning Complex is 156 fires for 10,000 acres. 66 active fires. 25 fires are unstaffed. 65 fires are contained. Significant fire activity is expected due to low RH, and steep topography. A mandatory evacuation was established in the community of Platina, Shingletown and Burney. Shingletown Fire - 470 acres and 80% contained, evacuations in place. Donkey Fire - 360+ acres, potential evacuations for Oak Run and Round Mtn. Democrat Fire - 360 acres with structures threatened in the communities of Shasta and Keswick. Kirkman Fire -1,500 acres, holding. Pine Fire – 1,000 acres, likely to impact to Hwy 299E within 12 hours. Venture Fire, East of Burney - 1000 acres, 20 structures threatened, evacuations in place. Power transmission lines are threatened HWY 89 and HWY 299E is closed in the area. Incident Command Team #10 assigned.

Siskiyou Unit: All 8 fires contained during initial attack for a total of 10 acres. No further reports.

Sonoma - Lake - Napa Unit: The SNU Lightning Complex is 17 fires for 13,094 acres. 4 active fires. 13 fires are contained. All fires are staffed. Walker Fire is 9,000 acres and 5% contained. The fire is characterized by a rapid rate of spread, long range spotting. The fire continues to threaten 35 structures with potential closure of Highway 20, Wilbur Hot Springs, Spring Valley Subdivision, and Transmission lines. The “Wild” Fire is 4,089 acres and 80% contained. Fire movement is expected to be minimal and poses a reduction in potential threat to the nearby 250 structures. Incident Command Team #3 to assume command today.

Tehama - Glenn Unit: The TGU Lightning Complex is Over 41 fires for 4,629 acres. 2 active fires. 39 fires are contained. Two fires of concern are Mill Fire in the Mill Creek drainage – 900+ acres and unstaffed, and the Antelope Fire – 900+, 10% contained.
