Objectives: Fill holes along trail to the mud hole as needed
Place rocks in hole

Elements: Front loader at rocks to load trailers
Rocks to mud hole a half yard at a time
Camping at Blackwood Canyon campground
Dinner hosted!

Plans: Decide what holes before the mud hole need filling
Do we try to move boulders?

Logistics: 100 yards of rock one mile from intersection
Two miles of total distance rocks need to move
50 yards of Grapefruit size
50 yards of small boulders
45 - 60 trips
12 - 15 trailers and vehicles to tow them
3 - 5 trips per rig
1 - 1.5 hours round trip
3 - 7.5 hours
40+ people to feed
Sign-in at Blackwood Canyon
15 Trailers and tow rigs
